Department of Geography both Day and Hindi Shift, Banwarilal Bhalotia College, Asansol, West Bengal, India have hosted a **one-day National Webinar on the theme “ Ecosystem Restoration: Striving Towards Sustainability”** on 5th June, 2021. 5th June is a day to remind the humans that they belong to the environment, which they have been recklessly destroying in quest of material advancement and comforts. We have to act now before it is too late and we cannot expect that the sole responsibility for conserving the environment lies with few environmentalists. Each of us must at our individual level try to contribute our bit in these efforts to protect the environment. The theme for World Environment Day, 2021 is **“Ecosystem Restoration”**. Ecosystem Restoration means assisting in the recovery of ecosystems that have been degraded or destroyed, as well as conserving the ecosystems that are still intact. Restoration initiatives can be launched by the government organizations, stakeholders and development agencies, local communities and even at individual level depending upon the degradation of environment at different scales. In this webinar we attempt to raise environmental awareness for the restoration of ecosystem on sustainable basis, to share different strategies adopted at international, national and regional level for the protection of environment, to explore educational and scholarly solutions for promoting biodiversity in this new normal living and to seek the recommendations on post-pandemic restorative initiatives.

The Summary Report for the Program is as follows:

The webinar held on virtual platform through **Cisco WebEx Meeting App**. The webinar started at 11.00am through **Welcome address by Dr. Chandana Singha, Head, Department of**

Geography, Banwarilal Bhalotia College, Asansol and Joint Convenor of the Webinar where she greeted the invited speakers and participants. In inaugural session **Dr. Amitava Basu, Principal, Banwarilal Bhalotia College, Asansol and Chairperson** of the Webinar lucidly elaborated the general theme of the webinar and its importance. The whole program was anchored in wonderful manner by **Ms. Madhumita Mondal, SACT-I** and **Ms. Sayantani Roy, SACT-II, Department of Geography, Banwarilal Bhalotia College, Asansol** and also a **member of the Organizing Committee**.

Dr. Manas Pal, HOD, Department of Geography Hindi Shift, proposed the vote of thanks. All the participants expressed their gratitude to the members of organizing committee of a full day national webinar by Banwarilal Bhalotia College for creating awareness on ecosystem restoration. The Women’s Cell of the college is looking forward to organize similar program in near future to encourage the student community as well as to empower the girl students of the College.







From December 21 to 22, 2021, Banwarilal Bhalotia College in Asansol, India, organised e-ConSus 2021, a two-day international e-conference on “Revisiting Strategies for Sustainable Development.” This is the continuation of e-ConSus 2020, an event hosted by the college with the goal of raising awareness and providing hope in the face of the devastating pandemic, as well as mobilising and integrating other institutions into a collaborative network to achieve common goals and reorient society toward a more sustainable future. e-ConSus 2020 was a huge success, with people from all around the world participating, taking action, and expressing gratitude. The mission continued with renewed vigour and enthusiasm through ConSus 2021 to restore and resuscitate the lives of the daily waged common man, poor farmers, and their families, who, despite producing a significant portion of the world’s food, are now suffering from hunger and a lack of health care and sanitary systems. Now is the time to embrace global solidarity and rebuild and recover from the pandemic in a way that addresses the

challenges and helps communities build long-term resilience.

The second international e-Conference on "Revisiting Strategies for Sustainable Development" received a huge response like the previous year from the stakeholders, cutting across all the enquiring layers of society with 656 registrations. Despite the dwindling interest in online seminars and conferences, this enormous number of registrations ensured participation from premier research institutes and universities across India. Apart from students, researchers, and academicians, there were registrations from non-government organisations and the common people, which further bolstered our commitment to the stated mission of the e-Conference. This time, there were 15 resource persons of repute from premier institutions in India and abroad, 3 more than last year, and 63 papers were selected for presentations compared to 27 papers presented last year. The e-Conference was organised in hybrid mode in light of the relaxation in COVID guidelines as a result of the ebbing of COVID cases. The online mode was hosted using the Google Meet Web Platform with YouTube live streaming, and all the participants were inducted into a Telegram Channel for speedy communication. The participants and presenters from B.B. College were hosted in recorded offline mode from the college premises. All the registrants were sent a Google Meet link and a YouTube Live Streaming link inviting them to watch a YouTube live streaming video of the conference in case the meeting room is exhausted. On day one of the conference, a soft copy of the abstract proceedings was launched and circulated among paper presenters.

The members of the organising committee distributed among themselves the tasks of anchoring, moderating, and technical logistics among themselves. During each session, the participants were requested to post their queries on the chatbox of Google Meet or YouTube Live, which were then taken up by the moderators who presented them to the resource people for their kind explanation of the doubts and questions of the participants. Feedback was taken at the end of each day of the e-Conference, which reflected outstanding responses from the participants.

Around 90% of the participants have given excellent or very good feedback on each of the sessions.

On the basis of the feedback received after each day, 117 participation certificates were issued. 63 presenters were provided with an e-Certificate as an acknowledgement of their intellectual contribution. The appreciation certificates for the resource persons and organising committee members were also issued for facilitating this great task of knowledge dissemination. The conference proceedings are with the publisher and being readied for publication with an ISBN and DOI.

Libraries are the repositories of knowledge since they house the books and other knowledge resources that are available, most of which are in print form. However, with the advent of digital technology and Internet connectivity, both the library scene and approaches for collection and curation are rapidly evolving. The digital revolution of the twentieth and twenty-first centuries, with the advancement of techniques and technology, has created new knowledge and spaces for humankind to evolve culturally.

A digital library is one such space or entry port where a user can discover new information with the help of and remixing of digital technology, Internet connectivity, and physical content. A digital library is also a means of researching and curating knowledge, as well as a creative space. It enhances the scale of access to information and knowledge by bridging barriers of time and space, and affords certain tools for remote reading. It prepared the way for Digital Humanities studies in the 2000s, which looked at how digital technologies were used in the humanities, liberal arts, social scientific scholarship, and beyond.

"Digital Humanities" examines the role, use, application, and impact of digital instruments in our daily lives, society, economics, cultures, and governments from a critical standpoint. Following the digital turn in memory institutions, the availability of a vast corpus of cultural artefacts, as well as the development of new types of digital objects and embodiments, has opened up new avenues for computational social science and humanities study, practise, and education. As various forms of culture are mediated, produced, accessed, distributed, or consumed via digital devices and technology, the question of whether something is "digital" or not becomes less important. The goal of the e-Conference on the Interface of Librarianship and Digital Humanities is to produce new ideas about the future of scholarship, which it aims to influence. Such an e-Conference of international stature was made possible by the collaboration with DH-IDRP of the Indian Institute of Technology, Jodhpur, India.

On the heels of the success of last year's e-LAN 2020, a webinar series, we have planned a Two Day International e-Conference for this year. The multidisciplinary e-Conference (e-LAN 2021) brought together prominent resource persons from the Indian and international Digital Humanities, Library, and Information Science communities to discuss and deliberate on the issues at hand. We received excellent paper presentations from the academic community, including faculty and research scholars. A plan is being developed to accommodate eligible papers for publication. The online mode was hosted using the Google Meet Web Platform with YouTube live streaming, and all the participants were inducted into a What's App group for speedy communication. All the registrants were sent a Google Meet link and a YouTube Live Streaming link inviting them to watch a YouTube live streaming video of the conference in case the meeting room is exhausted. During each session, the participants were requested to post their queries on the chatbox of Google Meet or YouTube Live, which were then taken up by the moderators who presented them to the resource people for their kind explanation of the doubts and questions of the participants. Feedback was taken at the end of each day of the e-Conference, which reflected outstanding responses from the participants.
