Department of Geography both Day and Hindi Shift, Banwarilal Bhalotia College, Asansol, West Bengal, India have hosted a **one-day National Webinar on the theme “Ecosystem Restoration: Striving Towards Sustainability”** on 5th June, 2021. 5th June is a day to remind the humans that they belong to the environment, which they have been recklessly destroying in quest of material advancement and comforts. We have to act now before it is too late and we cannot expect that the sole responsibility for conserving the environment lies with few environmentalists. Each of us must at our individual level try to contribute our bit in these efforts to protect the environment. The theme for World Environment Day, 2021 is **“Ecosystem Restoration”**. Ecosystem Restoration means assisting in the recovery of ecosystems that have been degraded or destroyed, as well as conserving the ecosystems that are still intact. Restoration initiatives can be launched by the government organizations, stakeholders and development agencies, local communities and even at individual level depending upon the degradation of environment at different scales. In this webinar we attempt to raise environmental awareness for the restoration of ecosystem on sustainable basis, to share different strategies adopted at international, national and regional level for the protection of environment, to explore educational and scholarly solutions for promoting biodiversity in this new normal living and to seek the recommendations on post-pandemic restorative initiatives.

The webinar held on virtual platform through **Cisco WebEx Meeting App**. The webinar started at 11.00am through **Welcome address by Dr. Chandana Singha, Head, Department of**

About the Institute - B.B. College, Asansol, West Bengal, India

Established in 1944, Banwarilal Bhalotia College (popularly known as B. B. College in the local fraternity), presently affiliated to Kazi Nazrul University, Asansol, India, is one of the leading educational institutions in the area, providing both general and technology-based education. The college boasts of a beautiful campus, spacious classrooms, well-equipped laboratories, state-of-the-art computing facilities, well-stocked libraries, and a large playground. It offers undergraduate courses in various subjects of arts, commerce, and science streams (both Honours and General). The three departments of Physics, Zoology, and Hindi are presently running postgraduate courses too. In keeping with the changing needs of the students, the college has introduced courses like BBA, BCA, and some departmental training & certificate courses like dry farming, vermicomposting, mobile repairing, mushroom cultivation, sericulture training, soil and water analysis, etc. Under the guidance of our highly dynamic principal Dr. Amitava Basu, we are very much hopeful that B. B. College will be able to nurture generations of enthusiastic learners in the years ahead. In 2010, B. B. College was declared as a “Centre with Potential for Excellence” by UGC, a rare achievement. Subsequently, in January 2020, the college has been re-accredited (Cycle 2) by the NAAC with a grade of B+. Throughout the pandemic, the college has made significant efforts to continue its academic and research activities online. Last year, we had one e-conference and a number of other webinars at college. We are organizing the current webinar in order to enrich the academic and research activity of our college.

About the Webinar – The core idea of this national webinar on “The Perspectives of Social Justice in India” is to describe about fairness and equity across many aspects of society pertaining to social justice. Social justice has to deal with the belief that all people should have equal rights and opportunity. However, there are lots of incidences of gross violation of social justice in India. Further, the significant aspects of this national webinar is to discuss and find various means and ends for social justice in India.

Concept Note:

- There are various perspectives on social Justice and every perspectives of Justice have their own backgrounds and agendas in justifying social Justice. Justice is defined by the relationship that exists between the individual and the state, which means that the state treats every person equally and seeks to resolve disputes on the basis of the facts and compared to objective criteria rather than a subjective determination. To Rawl's justice means fairness and ideally a goal towards creating a well ordered society. Social Justice is an important pillar of the society without which the whole society gets crumbled into ashes. Social justice is the way where the state delivers primary goods like social, economic and political liberties and rights to the every individual, who are the part of that society.
- "Justice without power is inefficient; power without justice is tyranny. Justice without power is opposed, because there are always wicked men. Power without justice is soon questioned. Justice and power must therefore be brought together, so that whatever is just may be powerful, and whatever is powerful may be just."- Blaise Pascal
- The role of the state is to distribute socio and economic goods in such a way so that, the social and economic gaps in the society are reduced and also to provide social and economic opportunities by creating social structures and institutions for the marginalized.
- India is a land of unity in diversity; we have diverse race, ethnic cultures, languages and traditions. Even in twenty first century the policy makers have failed to deliver social justice to the deprived citizens living in different corner of the states. There have been numerous social movements in the past and present yet, the very essence of democratic ideals are challenged by the multiple social issues in the country. The policy makers have not properly justified the notion of social justice in India. The multiple social and economic issues like say for instances, the cornering of the wealth in the hands of the few, rising unemployment, gender issues, environmental crisis, poor health and education, corruption and bad governance etc. has been the testimonials which projects the failure of the system to provide justice to the majority of its citizens. The meaning of the term social justice in the Indian constitution has been inadequate to cover such a vast topic like social justice. Constitution defines social Justice as an equal treatment of all citizens on the basis of caste, religion, colour, race, sex, and language. Therefore, the main goal of the webinar is to see perspectives on social justice beyond the definition provided in the fundamental rights of the Indian constitution.

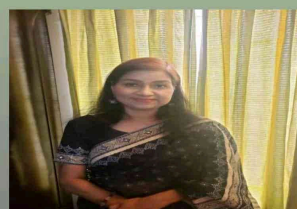
