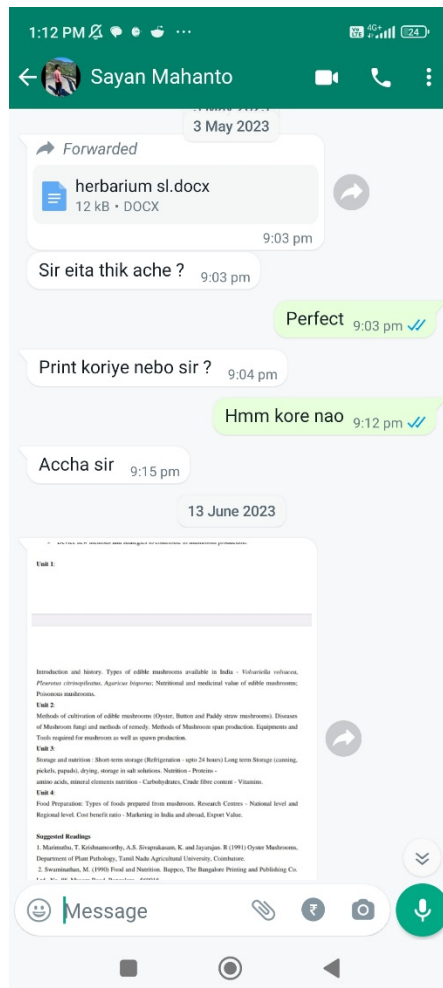

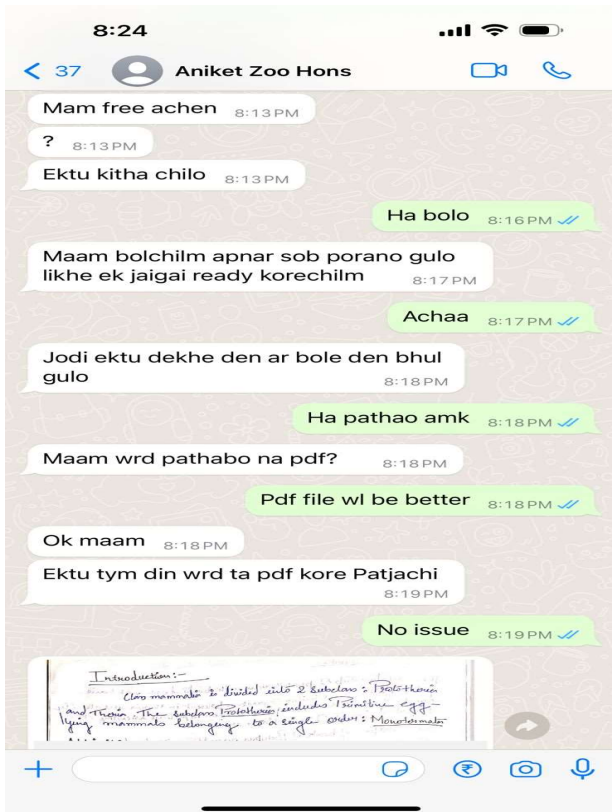

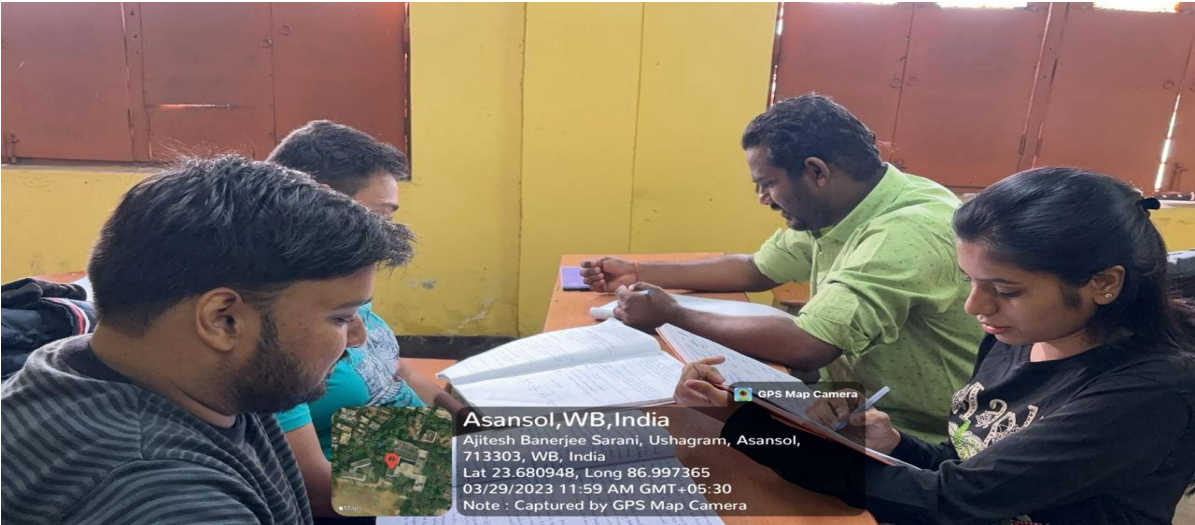
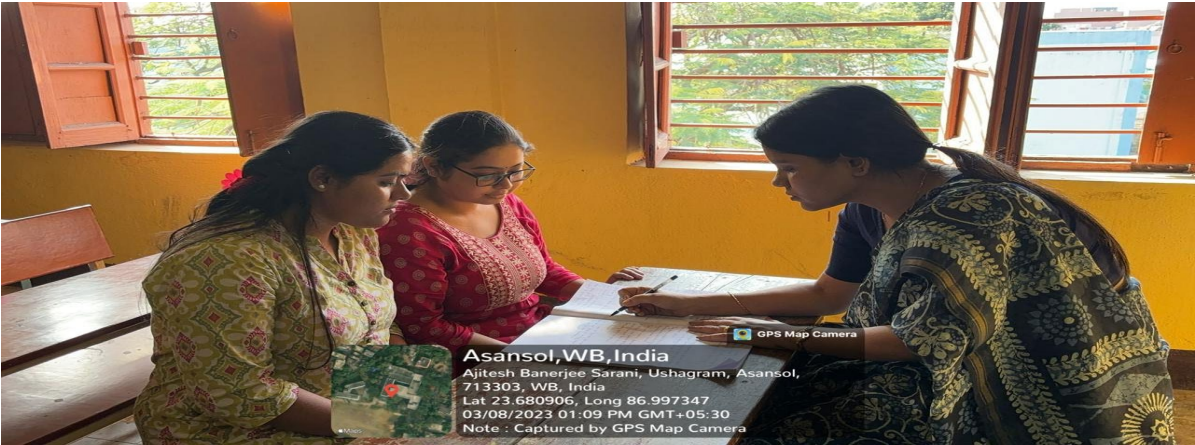

3.a) **Metamorphosis** :- The developmental process by which a 1st instar immature stage transformed into adult, is called as metamorphosis.

Endocrine control of metamorphosis in insects :-
There are three major types of hormone which are controlled the insect metamorphosis, these are :-

- Prothoracicotropic Hormone (PTTH)
- Ecdysone Hormone
- Juvenile hormone.

PTTH: Molting is initiated in the brain, where neurosecretory cell secrete PTTH in response to neural, hormonal and environmental factor. PTTH is a peptide hormone with molecular weight of 4K and 3K. PTTH induces prothoracic gland to produce ecdysteroid or ecdysone hormone.

Ecdysone: Ecdysone or 20 hydroxyecdysone initiates growth and molting. There are two types of ecdysone hormones present in the insect body: α -Ecdysone and β -ecdysone, which favours the development of adult characters and initiates molting process and differentiation of body tissues.

Juvenile hormone: Median Neurosecretory cells secrete Allotropic Hormone (ATH) which stimulates the corpora Allata to secrete juvenile hormone. There are five variants: JH-I, JH-II, JH-III, JH-O, ISOJH-O. JH-III promotes the larval development and inhibit the development of adult characters.

Role of Broad Complex in maintaining metamorphosis :-
JH maintains the status-quo of larval-larval molt by binding with Met protein, which activates the Krhl gene. Activated Krhl gene inhibits the activation of broad complex. In the presence of JH, during a molt ensures that the result of that molt produce another instar, not as pupa or an adult.
PTTH, in turn, induces prothoracic gland to secrete ecdysone.
