


Fig. 1: In the above pictures my mentee Md. Adil Ansari is seen presenting on a topic of Mathematics involving double integrals.

Action Taken: The mentees are guided accordingly. Following are some evidences.




Fig 2: Interaction with mentees

Among several such instances, some of the evidences of mentee specific issue are as follows:


Mentee Issue: One of my mentees Ms. Karishma Kumari Bind shared that she had been ill and asked to take care of her attendance.






Fig. 3 (b): Interaction with Monu Rao.


- 1. The Mentees were provided with the support and information regarding **technical problems** during enrolment, examination form fill up online through university (KNU) portal.

After considering the circumstances and taking permission from the External Teacher for that day, I granted him permission to sit for the exam.







Supplemental Learning Platform -I have created website for Course information of each semester, this helps students to know the progress of the course as per syllabus.



Mentorship Report for the Session 2023-2024

Mentees Allotted: Proportionately All the Semester students of 1st, 2nd/3rd, 4th/5th, 6th B.A. Education (Honours) are divided under the mentorship of Satyashree Rout and Poulomi Sarkar.

Satyashree Rout and Poulomi Sarkar considered this responsibility as a mentor very sincerely and tried to guide all their students (and especially the students in their mentee group) in every way possible. They kept them self readily available for the students and encouraged the students to communicate with them in case of any problems. Hence students approached them with various academic as well as non-academic issues; occasionally in a group for some general problems and sometimes individually for some personal problems. Satyashree Rout and PoulomiSarkar sincerely tried with their best effort to resolve each of those issues as early as possible. The students were quite satisfied with their mentorship duties. Following are some sample documents as mentorship records by Satyashree Rout and Poulomi Sarkar.

Some Issues & Their Resolution:

1. Providing Academic Support: As the new National Curriculum and Credit Framework Syllabus (NCCF) has been introduced to the Course Curriculum of all the Universities in India as per as the guidelines provided by UGC, many students found that the textbooks available in the market or the College Libraries were inadequate (to some extent) to cover the whole syllabus under this new CBCS framework. Hence, they frequently enquired about supplementary study materials for a better understanding of the topics.

Action Taken: This issue was resolved as a huge number of lecture notes along with an ample amount of soft copies of various reference books were provided by Satyashree Rout and Poulomi Sarkar to their students.

2. Proper Circulation of Various Notices: As University, College and Department issued various notices regarding admission, registration, enrolment, exam etc., the students often reported that they didn't get the notices/information at proper time.

Action Taken: In this regard, some dedicated WhatsApp groups were created and all the important notices were meticulously sorted and instantly forwarded by the faculty to the respective group of students so that they got the required information at proper time. Moreover, Satyashree Rout constantly encouraged the students to attend and participate in various Academic Seminars & Cultural/Sports Program organized by College/Department by posting the brochures/program schedules in their groups. Many Notices regarding Admission in Higher Education Institutes and Job/Campus Interviews were also forwarded by Satyashree Rout for the benefit of the students.

3. Providing Technical Support: As per the Government Guidelines, the Universities and Colleges introduced online portals for all the activities like Admission, Registration, Enrolment, Publication of Results etc. Many students were not so digitally advanced and they faced various major or minor technical problems.

Action Taken: SatyashreeRout was very much concerned regarding this problem and he made himself readily available for the students facing technical problems. Some general technical issues like login, scan & uploading of documents, filling up the forms etc. were addressed by SatyashreeRout through the common WhatsApp groups of the students. However, some problems required individual attention which were sorted and solved through personal communication with proper discretion.

4. To Develop Problem Solving Capability: Some students reported their inability to solve some problems by themselves of their Course Syllabus, despite they understood the topics covered in their class hours. In most of these cases, the students approached the teachers outside the classes.

Action Taken: Though Department had arranged some Tutorial Classes for the overall benefit of the students in this regard, some students still faced difficulties. Whenever they contacted Satyashree Rout and Poulomisarkar regarding some specific problems, they tried to solve them and elaborately demonstrated the solutions/hints to the corresponding student through telephonic conversation/WhatsApp chat to enable his/her problem-solving skills.

5. Counselling for Higher Studies: Some of the students wanted to advance their career through higher studies like doing M.A, Ph.D or Integrated Ph.D. However, they were pretty much clueless about how to prepare themselves for the Entrance Exams or how to apply properly for admission. Some of them asked to help him/her to choose the topics of Specialization. In this regard, they sought guidance from the teachers.

Action Taken: Satyashree Rout whole heartedly tried at his best to provide proper guidance to the students regarding the preparation for the exams, procedures of admission, to select the choice of Specialization topics etc. Proper counselling was provided to each individual student for every necessary steps. Some sample screenshots of WhatsApp chats are provided below.

Description:

As per the general guidelines provided by UGC and the college authority, Department of Education, B. B. College, Asansol provides a dynamic mentoring system for benefit and up-liftment of the departmental students. The students of each semester are divided into separate groups and a faculty is assigned to be the mentor for a particular group. The Department issues a notice in this regard well in advance. Each of the mentors tries to address the issues raised by the corresponding students. However, the students are also encouraged to contact the other faculties (other than their mentor) regarding their problems, if needed. Most of the students are very much satisfied with this mentorship system as provided by the Department. Following are some of the aspects which were dealt during the academic sessions of 2023-24.

- 1. Providing advices and technical assistance during subject selection and filling up of admission forms at the time of their admission. This type of guidance is also provided during examination form fill-up process.
- 2. Guiding and assisting the students to avail different scholarships as suitable for them.
- 3. Introducing and encouraging students to consult various reference books and lecture notes (both offline & online). Some YouTube based teaching videos or links of important useful lectures are also shared with the students.
- 4. Introduction to the MOOC based learning platforms like NPTEL, Swayam, ePathshala, NDLI, Inflibnet etc. This is done as a whole by our librarian at the beginning of the session.
- 5. Helping them to prepare for different types of competitive exams and guiding them for next higher level (PG) studies and preparation for entrance tests.
- 6. Dealing personal problems viz. health related issues, personal matters, economic problem etc.

- 6. Guiding students in applying various scholarships.



STUDENTS MENTORING SYSTEM

Description:

As per the general guidelines provided by UGC and the college authority, Department of HISTORY Day Shift, B. B. College, Asansol provides a dynamic mentoring system for benefit and upliftment of the departmental students. The students of each semester are divided into separate groups and a faculty is assigned to be the mentor for a particular group. The Department issues a notice in this regard well in advance. Each of the mentors tries to address the issues raised by the corresponding students. However, the students are also encouraged to contact the other faculties (other than their mentor) regarding their problems, if needed. Most of the students are verymuch satisfied with this mentorship system as provided by the Department. Following are some of the aspectswhich were dealt during the academic sessions of 2022-2023 & 2023-2024:

- 1. Providing advices and technical assistance during subject selection and filling up of admission forms at the time of their admission. This type of guidance is also provided during examination form fill-up process.
- 2. Guiding and assisting the students to avail different scholarships as suitable for them.
- 3. Introducing and encouraging students to consult various reference books and lecture notes (both offline & online). Some YouTube based teaching videos or links of important useful lectures are also shared with the students.
- 4. Helping them to prepare for different types of competitive exams and guiding them for next higher level (PG) studies and preparation for entrance tests.
- 5. Dealing personal problems viz. health related issues, personal matters, economic problem etc. The detail Mentorship Reports of the individual faculties are attached herewith.

Mentorship Report for the Session 2023-24

Name of Faculty with Designation: Sri Amrita Haldar, Assistant Professor, Dept. of History

Mentees Allotted: 1st & 2nd Semester Students of B.A History (Honours) (The detail list of the Mentees is attached in a separate file)

Sri Amrita Haldar considered this responsibility as a mentor very sincerely and tried to guide all his students (and especially the students in his mentee group) in every way possible. He kept himself readily available for the students and encouraged the students to communicate with him in case of any problems. Hence students from all the semesters (other than the mentees as well) approached him with various academic as well as non-academic issues; occasionally in a group for some general problems and sometimes individually for some personal problems. He sincerely tried with his best effort to resolve each of those issues as early as possible. The students were quite satisfied with his mentorship duties.

Some Issues & Their Resolution:

1. Providing Academic Support: As the new Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) has been introduced to the Course Curriculum of all the Universities in India as per as the guidelines provided by UGC, many students found that the textbooks available in the market or the College Libraries were inadequate (to some extent) to cover the whole syllabus under this new CBCS framework. Hence, they frequently enquired about supplementary study materials for a better understanding of the topics.

Action Taken: This issue was resolved as a huge number of lecture notes along with an sample amount of soft copies of various reference books were provided by the concern mentor to his students.

2. Proper Circulation of Various Notices: As University, College and Department issued various notices regarding admission, registration, enrollment, exam etc., the students complained that they didn't get the notices/information at proper time.

Action Taken: In this regard, some definite Whats App groups were created and all the important notices were meticulously sorted and instantly forwarded by the mentor to the respective groups of students so that they got the required information at proper time. Moreover, the mentor constantly encouraged the students to attend and participate in various Academic Seminars & Cultural/Sports Program organized by College/Department by posting the brochures/program schedules in their groups.

3. Providing Technical Support: As per the Government Guidelines, the Universities and Colleges introduced online portals for all the activities like Admission, Registration, Enrollment, Publication of Results etc. Many students were not so digitally advanced and they faced various major or minor technical problems.

Action Taken: The Mentor was very much concerned regarding this digital devide and he made himself readily available for the students facing technical problems. Some general technical issues like login, scan & uploading of documents, filling up the forms etc. were addressed by the mentor through the common WhatsApp groups of the students.

4. To Develop Problem Solving Capability: Some students reported their inability to solve some problems by themselves of their Course Syllabus, despite they understood the topics covered in their class hours. In most of these cases, the students approached the teachers outside the classes. Moreover, some students also sought some guidance regarding solving the sample questions/problems for various Competitive Exams like M.A, NET, SET, SSC etc.

Action Taken: Though Department had arranged some Tutorial Classes for the overall benefit of the students in this regard, some students still faced difficulties. Whenever they contacted the mentor regarding some specific problems, the mentor tried to solve them and elaborately demonstrated the solutions/hints to the corresponding student through telephonic conversation/WhatsApp chat to enable his/her problem-solving skills.

5. Counselling for Higher Studies: Some of the students wanted to advance their career through higher studies like doing M.A, B.Ed, or Integrated Ph.D. However, they were pretty much clueless about how to prepare themselves for the Entrance Exams or how to apply properly for admission. Some of them asked to help him/her to choose the topics of Specialization. In this regard, they sought guidance from the teachers.

Action Taken: The mentor wholeheartedly tried at his best to provide proper guidance to the students regarding the preparation for the exams, procedures of admission, to select the choice of Specialization topics etc. Proper counseling was provided to each individual student for every necessary

steps.6.

6. Mentoring for Exhibition: Like every year, our College also organized the Exhibition in the Session 2019-2020. However, the students were confused about which topics to choose for modeling/demonstration purposes for this Program.

Action Taken: Some demonstrations regarding various project topics on Bishnupur Art & Architecture among the students and they were very much encouraged by the mentor to come up with their suggestions and to participate in the Exhibition.

In the session 2023-2, a group of 30 students of first semester was allotted as mentees under me for the odd as well as even semesters.

General Issues The program was aimed at dealing with different problems like filling of registration forms, submission of college fees, departmental queries (like seminar library, routine, recommended books), syllabus, problems in topics, assignment questions, tests related problems, problems during initial covid pandemic period regarding regular online classes through Google meet, study materials, pdfs through WhatsApp group and through college websites.

Some Issues & Their Resolution:

1. Providing Academic Support: As the new Learning Outcome based Curriculum Framework (LOCF) was introduced to the Course Curriculum from the Session 2020-2021 along with the ongoing CBCS and since the College Libraries were closed due to COVID-19 Pandemic, many students faced a huge problem and they often required soft copies of books, study materials & video lectures for their online classes.

Action Taken: A huge collection of soft copies of various text & reference books along with a plenty of lecture notes were provided by the mentor to his students.

2. Mentoring for upGrad Platform: As the College Authority introduced upGrad, a centralized online teaching-learning platform for a smooth functioning of the online classes, this was altogether very new both to the teachers and students. Almost all the students faced some difficulties to adopt to this new platform and there were numerous issues to be addressed.

Action Taken: The Mentor was assigned the duties as one of the few Admins for implementation of this upGrad platform by the College Authority, the names of all the students of History Department were collected and each of them were meticulously enlisted to the upGrad database by him. Further, the students were thoroughly guided by the mentor at each step of login and to join their respective classrooms to ensure that every single student can avail this online facility.

3. Proper Circulation of Various Notices: As the teaching-learning process was continued through online mode, all the notices regarding admission, registration, enrollment, exam etc. were issued virtually either through email, WhatsApp or SMS services. In this regard, the students were very much anxious to get the notices/information at proper time.

Action Taken: Dedicated WhatsApp groups were created and all the important notices were meticulously sorted and instantly forwarded by the mentor to the respective group of students so that they got the required information at proper time. Moreover, the mentor constantly encouraged the students to attend and participate in various Academic Seminars & Cultural/Sports Program organized by College/Department by posting the brochures/program schedules in their groups.

Providing Technical Support: The University and our College functioned through online mode for all the regular academic and administrative activities like Admission, Registration, Enrollment, Publication of Results etc. Many students were not so digitally advanced and they faced various major or minor technical problems.

Action Taken: Being very much concerned regarding this problem, the mentor made himself readily available for the students facing such technical problems. The students received prompt response in reply to their complains and most of the issues were resolved very quickly as they required immediate attention. Some general technical issues like login, scan & uploading of documents, filling up the forms etc. were addressed by mentor through the common WhatsApp groups of the students.

Mentor-Mentee Report for 2023-24

The Mentor-Mentee Program was introduced in an organized way in the session 2017-18. In the session 2020-21, a group of 30 students of first semester was allotted as mentees under me for the odd as well as even semesters.

General Issues The program was aimed at dealing with different problems like filling of registration forms, submission of college fees, departmental queries (routine, notices, etc), online classes, registration under online platforms (UPGRAD), syllabus, problems in topics, online study materials etc

Actions taken

- 1. The problems like not being able to registered in UPGRAD Online platform were solved through WhatsApp group. Some academic queries were discussed over the phone calls and were answered in no time.








Interaction of Shanoly Ganguly, Department of Philosophy with quick learners & slow learners during recess hours








Interaction of Shanoly Ganguly, Department of Philosophy with quick learners & slow learners during recess hours




