
























Meritorious and topper students were also awarded at the occasion.

Report on Green Muse Philia initiative: "Transforming Waste into Art"

The Central Library and Beagle – Nature Club unit of Banwarilal Bhalotia College, Asansol successfully hosted an engaging and thought-provoking workshop titled "Transforming Waste into Art". 



A Brief report on


Impact and Takeaways

workshop served as a catalyst for personal growth, inspiring participants to use theatre as a tool for self-discovery and social connection.




