- b. The ownership of any project-related output, including reports and findings, will be discussed and agreed upon prior to the commencement of the project.


Termination:





1. Background

Durgapur Women's College has been accredited with a B++ Grade by NAAC. The college, instituted in 1980, has been established as the first degree college with the express aim of education of girl students living in the vicinity of the Steel City of Durgapur. The establishment of the college was taken up as a Project of the DNAA (now Durgapur Municipal Corporation). The college was initially affiliated to the University of Burdwan and now has been affiliated to Kazi Nazrul University, Asansol. Empowering Women academically, culturally, socially, and economically is the stated mission of Durgapur Women's College. With this in view, the college envisages expanding on the frontiers of economic empowerment by opening opportunities for professional development. It offers undergraduate courses in arts, commerce, and sciences. Along with different educational programs and various cocurricular activities, the college runs various vocational courses leading to the employment of the students. The college runs a distance education centre of IGNOU on the college campus. The College also provides hostel facility to the students coming from distant places.

Banwarilal Bhalotia College presently affiliated with Kazi Nazrul University is one of the leading educational institutions in Asansol, providing both general and technology-based education. The college is blessed with a beautiful campus, spacious classrooms, well-equipped laboratories, adequate computer labs, well-stocked libraries, and a playground. Besides traditional undergraduate and postgraduate courses in various subjects of Arts, Commerce, and Science streams, the college, in tune with the changing needs of higher education, has introduced courses like B.B.A., B.C.A., Environmental Sciences and Water Management, and training courses in dry farming, cultivation of aromatic and medicinal plants, mushroom, lac, cultivation, vermin composting, sericulture, and soil water analysis. The college runs three distance education centers such as IGNOU, NSOU, and MANUU. In 2010, the college was declared a "Centre with Potential for Excellence" by the UGC. In 2012, the UGC introduced three career oriented courses in Functional English, Mobile Repairing, and Vermin composting, which were run successfully by the college for three years. The college has o been re-accredited (cycle 2) by the NAAC with a grade of B+ in 2020.

INDEMNITY:

About the Institutions


