About the Career Counselling and Placement Cell:

The career counselling and placement cell was set up in 2014 with the aim of providing not only career counselling and job placement but also to provide information of different scholarships and competitive exams. The cell also has a function to act a mentor to guide different students to their domain on the basis of their interest and capabilities. Another function of this cell is to reduce fear in learners, almost all of whom worry about career prospects after college. The Career Counselling and Placement Cell falls under the administrative control of the IQAC of Banwarilal Bhalotia College. The Cell has been allotted a separate complex with a well structured committee consisting of the convenor and several members. A Network group is present, where one or two faculties of all the departments of the college are included. Information on career prospects are communicated to this group as and when they develop. The concerned department members then pass the information to the students, to ensure the delivery of information. Apart from that information is also communicated on the college website. The Cell has been able to invite several multinational companies and institutions for job recruitments.
